Eventually the pressure paid, when from a quickly taken corner Chickerell's defenders failed to intercept the ball as it came across the area, leaving a Corfe attacker ghosting in at the far post to slot home.

Then just before half time as Corfe pressed, Chickerell conceded a second corner where an attempted headed clearance was diverted into his own net by the unfortunate Shaun Parker leaving the home side 2-0 up at the interval.

In the second half Corfe piled on the pressure, allowing Chickerell little time on the ball, with their slick passing and movement which at times left Chickerell chasing shadows, and it was no surprise when they stretched their lead, scoring two quick well worked goals, the fourth coming from a great run and cross which produced a superb headed finish, putting the home side out of sight.

Undeterred, Chickerell still tried to forge a way through however Josh Golsby in the away goal was always the busier of the two goalkeepers, and had it not been for some great saves in the second half, the score would have been much higher. Chickerell tried to gain some sort of control, but with Barnes left isolated in attack any outlet to him was instantly cut off by the Corfe defenders, and as they piled on the pressure to Chickerell's tiring defence two more quick fire goals finished Chickerell off.
